

Annosum Root Rot preventive spraying requirements will be implemented if Annosum is found within Oneida County or an adjacent county prior to or during the period of this contract. See Timber Sale Contract for details.

Additional Regulations

- In the Pine Area, harvest all orange marked pine and hardwood, leaving orange paint on the stumps. Do not harvest any other trees. Logging is permitted year round in the pine as long as the ground is dry enough or frozen to prevent rutting. If rutting occurs, frozen ground only restrictions will be applied. No damage to the residual trees will be tolerated. In the Hardwood/Aspen Area: Harvest all orange marked hardwood leaving orange visible on the stump, all Aspen and W. Birch larger than 6" diameter, all merchantable Balsam Fir and all Ironwood. Do not harvest any other trees. Activity in the hardwood is limited to Aug 15 to Spring breakup (March 15)
- All pine cut from April 1 - August 15 must be skidded and hauled within 2 weeks. No whole tree skidding of Pine. Maximum pole length is 19'. Utility poles will be dealt with on a tree by tree basis.
- Utilization in both areas is 100" stick to a 4" top or as bid.
- If harvesting whole tree, every 10th tree top above the standard 4" diameter must be left in the woods where the tree was felled.
- Absolutely no skidding or decking on the Wickham Rd or Camp 6 Rd or within their ditch lines. Any new roads or landings must have approval of the County prior to construction. All roads and landings must be levelled and cleared of debris upon completion of sale. Bond money will not be returned until road/landing rehab is complete.
- No equipment, skidding, decking or slash is permitted in the lowland areas within or adjacent to the sale or within the reserve/riparian zone. All slash must be cut to no higher than 2' off the ground. Stump height may not exceed 10".
- BMP's must be followed on all aspects of the sale.
- The remnants of a homestead lie in the western part of the north pine area. These features will be flagged prior to harvesting and must be avoided. No skidding on or over these features and felling of trees on them must be avoided.
- All terms of the Timber Sale Contract also apply.
