

**Additional Regulations**

1. In the the sale area harvest all Aspen, White Birch, Ironwood and only those other trees marked with orange, leaving orange visible on the stump. Do not harvest any trees within the aspen pocket adjacent to Shingle Mill Rd..
2. Within the pink painted canopy gap areas harvest all stems 2" diameter or larger and harvest all pink marked trees.
3. Harvesting activities are limited to the dates between August 15 and the following spring breakup and only when the ground is dry enough or frozen to prevent rutting. If rutting occurs, frozen ground only restrictions will be enforced.
4. Utilization is 100" stick to a 4" top or as bid. If utilizing whole tree, every 10th tree top above the standard 4" top diameter must remain in the woods where the tree was felled.
5. No whole tree skidding. Trees must be topped in the woods. Slash must be pulled back 25 ft from Shingle Mill Rd and cut to no higher than 2 ft. off the ground within 50 ft of Shingle Mill Rd. Slash treatment beyond 50 ft is not required. Damage to existing regeneration must be minimized. If damage is deemed excessive by the County the contract may be cancelled.
6. Any new roads or landings must have permission of the County prior to construction. All trails must be leveled and left in original condition or better at the end of each harvest season. Bond money will not be returned until all road/landing rehabilitation is complete.
7. Any dead standing trees (snags, cavity trees) must be left standing unless they pose a hazard.
8. No equipment, skidding, decking or slash is permitted in the wetlands within or adjacent to the sale. Any rutting adjacent to the wetlands will result in frozen ground only restrictions or cancellation of contract. All applicable BMP's must be followed during all phases of the sale. No skidding or decking on Shingle Mill Rd or within the ditch lines except forwarding across the road to use existing landing on the south side of Shingle Mill Rd. The road must be frozen or dry enough to prevent any damage to it.
9. Any trees felled across the blue paint line must be pulled back onto County property prior to limbing.
10. Absolutely no equipment, slash or harvesting is allowed in the RMZ.
