

1. Pine Thinning (29 Acres): Harvest every third row of red pine, all balsam, all aspen, and all mixed hardwoods. In areas where rows are not distinct, continue cutting 15' wide rows leaving 30' uncut. DO NOT HARVEST ANY MATURE PINE 12" DBH OR LARGER.

Aspen Regeneration Harvest (8 Acres): Harvest all aspen, mixed hardwoods, and balsam. DO NOT HARVEST ANY PINE OR SPRUCE.

2. All Pine cut from April 1- August 15 must be skidded and hauled within 2 weeks. If Annosum is discovered within Oneida County prior to the completion of the pine thinning area, stump applied Annosum treatments will be required.

3. Harvesting activities are limited to periods when the ground is dry enough or frozen to prevent rutting. If rutting occurs, frozen ground only restrictions will be enforced. No equipment allowed in the RMZ.

4. Utilization is 100" stick to a 4" top.

5. Any new roads or landings must have permission of the County prior to construction. All trails must be leveled and left in original condition or better at the end of each harvest season. Trail access to pine must be closed with rock or berm at the end of sale. ATV trail must be left open and in a safe useable condition at all times. Any signs removed during road work must be replaced immediately in a position making them effective for their purpose. Bond money will not be returned until all road/landing rehabilitation is complete. No skidding or decking on the Town Roads or their ditch lines.

6. Any dead standing trees (snags, cavity trees) must be left standing unless they pose a hazard.

7. No equipment, skidding, decking or slash is permitted in the wetlands within or adjacent to the sale. Any rutting adjacent to the wetlands will result in frozen ground only restrictions or cancellation of contract. All applicable BMP's must be followed during all phases of the sale. No skidding or decking on McCord Rd. or within the ditch lines.

8. Any trees felled across the blue paint line or onto ATV trail must be pulled back onto County property prior to limbing.

9. Slash must be pulled back 25 ft from McCord Rd. and ATV trails and must be cut to no higher than 2 ft. within 50 ft of McCord Rd. and ATV trails. Slash treatment beyond 50 ft is not required.

10. All terms of the Timber Sale Contract also apply.
