

1. Pine Thinning (30 Acres): Harvest all balsam, jack pine, aspen, mixed hardwoods within plantation, and trees marked with orange paint.
Aspen Regeneration Harvest (33 Acres): Harvest all aspen, mixed hardwoods, balsam, and oak not marked with green paint. DO NOT HARVEST ANY PINE, TAMARACK, CEDAR, SPRUCE, OAK 5" OR SMALLER, OR TREES MARKED WITH GREEN PAINT. NO CUTTING ALLOWED WITHIN PURPLE MARKED LEAVE ISLAND.
2. All Pine cut from April 1- August 15 must be skidded and hauled within 2 weeks. Stump applied fungicides may have to be applied by a certified applicator if Annosum is discovered in Oneida County prior to finishing the pine area of the sale. See Timber Sale contract for details.
3. Harvesting activities are limited to periods when the ground is dry enough or frozen to prevent rutting. If rutting occurs, frozen ground only restrictions will be enforced.
4. Utilization is 100" stick to a 4" top or as bid. If utilizing whole tree, every 10th tree top above the standard 4" top diameter must remain in the woods where the tree was felled. Maximum skidding length is 20' for pine. Utility poles will be delt with on a case by case basis.
5. Any new roads or landings must have permission of the County prior to construction. All trails must be leveled and left in original condition or better at the end of each harvest season. Snowmobile trail must be left open and in a safe useable condition at all times. Any signs removed during road work must be replaced immediately in a position making them effective for their purpose. Only one crossing of the ski trail may be used during ski season in northern regeneration harvest. Bond money will not be returned until all road/landing rehabilitation is complete. No skidding or decking on the Town Roads or their ditch lines.
6. All dead standing trees (snags) must be cut within 50' of a recreational trail. All other snags must be left within the regeneration harvests, unless they pose a safety hazard.
7. No equipment, skidding, decking or slash is permitted in the wetlands within or adjacent to the sale. Any rutting adjacent to the wetlands will result in frozen ground only restrictions or cancellation of contract. All applicable BMP's must be followed during all phases of the sale.
8. Any trees felled across the blue paint line or onto trails must be pulled back onto County property prior to limbing.
9. Slash must be pulled back 25 ft from Sheep Ranch Rd. and recreational trails and it must be cut to no higher than 2 ft. within 50 ft of Sheep Ranch Rd. and recreational trails. Slash treatment beyond 50 ft is not required.
10. All terms of the Timber Sale Contract also apply.
