


Twin Maples Sale



- ⊙ Berm




Twin Maples Sale



206 Acres, Hardwood Thinning- Harvest all aspen and white birch greater than 6", all balsam and ironwood greater than 1", and trees marked with orange paint. Avoid damage to young regeneration. Do not cut any 20" and larger Aspen in the area marked with (A)




21 Acres, Overstory Removal- Harvest all aspen, white birch, mixed hardwoods, and balsam. DO NOT HARVEST ANY SPRUCE, PINE, OAK, YELLOW BIRCH, OR TREES MARKED WITH GREEN PAINT. No Shearing required in these units. Avoid damage to regeneration.



15 Acres, Regeneration Harvest- Harvest all aspen, white birch, mixed hardwoods, balsam, and oak. DO NOT HARVEST ANY SPRUCE, PINE, YELLOW BIRCH, OR TREES MARKED WITH GREEN PAINT. Shearing required in these units. Shear or cut all stems 1" dia. and greater except oak 5" and smaller.



Lowland Keg, Kegs are mixed throughout the sale. Large kegs are indicated on the map. No harvesting or equipment allowed within 15' of a keg within or adjacent to a regeneration harvest. Purchaser must follow all applicable BMP's.



1. Hardwood Thinning (206 Acres): Hardwood Thinning- Harvest all aspen and white birch greater than 6", all balsam and ironwood greater than 1", and trees marked with orange paint. Excessive damage, as determined by the sale administrator, to young regeneration MUST be avoided.

Overstory Removal Harvest (21 Acres): Harvest all aspen, white birch, mixed hardwoods, and balsam. DO NOT HARVEST ANY SPRUCE, PINE, OAK, YELLOW BIRCH, OR TREES MARKED WITH GREEN PAINT. NO Shearing required in these units. Excessive damage, as determined by the sale administrator, to young regeneration MUST be avoided. If excessive damage occurs, additional equipment restrictions will be imposed.

Hardwood Regeneration Harvest (15 Acres): Harvest all aspen, white birch, mixed hardwoods, balsam, and oak. DO NOT HARVEST ANY SPRUCE, PINE, YELLOW BIRCH, OR TREES MARKED WITH GREEN PAINT. Shearing required in these units. Shear or cut all stems 1" dia. and greater except oak 5" and smaller.
2. Areas of advanced regeneration and young aspen will be omitted from shearing requirement as determined by sale administrator. Large and hollow 22" and greater aspen will be omitted from harvesting in western unit marked with an "A" on sale map as determined by sale administrator.
3. Harvesting is permitted during the period between August 15th and spring break up. Harvesting is limited to periods when ground is dry or frozen enough to prevent rutting. If rutting occurs, frozen ground only restrictions will be enforced.
4. Utilization is 100" stick to a 4" top or as bid. If utilizing whole tree, every 10th tree top above the standard 4" top diameter must remain in the woods where the tree was felled. Whole site is biomass suitable. If utilizing whole tree, trees MUST be topped where felled. NO WHOLE TREE SKIDDING.
5. Any new roads or landings must have permission of the County prior to construction. All trails and roads must be leveled and left in original condition or better at the end of each harvest season. ADA trail must be left open and in a safe useable condition at all times. ADA gate must be closed at the end of each day and during periods of inactivity. Any signs removed during road work must be replaced immediately in a position making them effective for their purpose. Bond money will not be returned until all road/landing rehabilitation is complete.
6. All dead standing trees (snags) must be left unless they pose a safety hazard.
7. No equipment, skidding, decking or slash is permitted in the wetlands within or adjacent to the sale. No trees may be cut within 15' of a keg located within or adjacent to a regeneration harvest. Any rutting adjacent to the wetlands will result in frozen ground only restrictions or cancellation of contract. All applicable BMP's must be followed during all phases of the sale.
8. Any trees felled across the blue paint line or onto trails must be pulled back onto County property prior to limbing.
9. Slash must be pulled back 25 ft from recreational trails and it must be cut to no higher than 2 ft. within 50 ft of recreational trails. Slash treatment beyond 50 ft is not required.
10. All terms of the Timber Sale Contract also apply.
