

### Additional Regulations

1. In the Aspen Harvest area cut all trees 1" diameter and larger except Pine, Spruce, Cherry, Elm, Burr Oak and Green Marked Trees. Oak not containing one 100" stick to a 4" top diameter do not need to be cut. Due to Oak Wilt concerns operations are limited to the period between Aug 1 and the following spring breakup. No operations are allowed, including road building, cutting and skidding outside this time period.

In the RMZ's harvest only those aspen and hardwood not marked with green paint. Do not cut any pine or spruce in these areas. No equipment is to be operated within 15 ft. of the lake. Ground must be dry or frozen to prevent rutting. No trees are to be felled into the lake. All slash must be pulled a minimum of 25 ft from the lake and must be cut to less than 2 ft high within the RMZ's. No landing sites are allowed within the RMZ's. No skidding across channel between Newbold Lk and the pond to the north.

2. Utilization in both areas is 100" stick to a 4" top -NO WHOLE TREE HARVESTING ALLOWED.

3. No harvesting, equipment or slash is allowed in the Restricted Area along Hemlock Rd. All trees felled into wetland areas must be pulled back onto the sale area prior to limbing. All slash must be pulled back 25 ft from Hemlock Rd and must be cut to no higher than 2 ft within 50 ft of the road. Slash treatment beyond 50 ft is not required.

4. All landing sites and roads must have approval of the County prior to construction. All roads must be closed with a berm or rocks, and must be leveled and returned to their original condition or better at the end of each harvest season and at the end of the sale. Bond money will not be returned until all road/landing work is completed.

5. No equipment, skidding, decking or slash is permitted in the lowland areas within or adjacent to the sale. No equipment may be operated within 15 ft of any wetland unless the ground is dry or frozen.

6. BMP's must be followed on all aspects of the sale.

7. All dead standing trees must be left standing unless they pose a safety hazard.

8. All terms of the Timber Sale Contract also apply.
