





# PERCH LAKE PARK

Perch Lake Park is located in the Cassian/Woodboro block of the Oneida County Forest. The park consists of an enclosed, heated shelter building with a covered deck with fireplace, vault toilets, disabled access fishing pier and a grassy picnic area. Picnic grills and tables are located in the picnic area. The park serves as a trail head for the Washburn Lake Silent Trails Area which has 12 miles of groomed ski trails and 6 miles of single track bike / snowshoe trails. The shelter may be reserved for private functions. Contact the Forestry Office for more information on shelter reservations.

Perch Lake is a non-motorized lake. Fish species found in the lake include Blue Gills, Perch and Trout. A boat landing is located on the west side of the lake. No swimming is allowed at the park.

The park is open from 6:00 AM until 10:00 PM. No overnight camping. No glass bottles. No dogs allowed in picnic area or inside shelter building. For a full set of regulations see sign board posted in parking lot or refer to Ch. 14 of the Oneida County General Code.
