**MABAS:** Chief Kinnally stated the next MABAS meeting will be Wednesday, December 12<sup>th</sup> at the Minocqua Fire Department. The Radio Drill will begin at 6:00p.m., the meeting at 6:30 p.m. followed by a short training session. Chief Kinnally also discussed Card Updates and Interdivisional Cards. Tim Magnin from Oconto County is the new Northeast Area Regional MABAS Coordinator.
