**POSITION:** Park LTE

**LOCATION:** Oneida County, WI. Reporting work station in Rhinelander.

**RATE OF PAY:** \$11.89/hr.

**WORK SCHEDULE:** Typical work schedule Monday – Friday 7:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. with a half hour unpaid lunch (7.5 hrs/day - 37.5 hrs per week).

**JOB DUTIES:** Include but are not limited to the following; assist with the general maintenance and development of county forest facilities, such as county parks, recreational trails, campground, disc golf course, swimming beaches, picnic areas, boat landings, toilet buildings, facility parking lots, forest roads, and maintenance garage. Work assignments will include trash collection, painting, small tree/brush removal, raking, cleaning (toilet buildings, park shelters, etc.), gate repair/installation, trail maintenance & development, minor carpentry/construction, weed trimming, operation and maintenance of basic power tools, pick-up truck, chainsaw, and lawn maintenance equipment, tractor, and ATV.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Must be willing to work outside under harsh conditions, must be able to work independently with little supervision, ability to lift a minimum of 50 lbs., walk long distances on uneven ground, and communicate effectively with public. Must possess a valid Wisconsin Driver's License throughout employment, experience with the operation of small power tools, chainsaw, hydraulic log splitter and lawn maintenance equipment is desirable. Oneida County Forestry Department policy requires that all LTE's wear appropriate clothing for fieldwork including steel-toed work boots, long work pants (denim, duck/canvas, etc.), and rain gear as needed. These items are considered personal work wear, and as such, the employee is expected to provide these items.

**LENGTH OF EMPLOYMENT:** Approximately 500 hours.
