You may claim the Lottery and Gaming Credit for 2017 taxes, payable in 2018, if on January 1, 2017 you owned the property and used the property as your primary residence. You can have only one primary residence. You cannot claim this credit on business property, rental units, land, garages or properties that are not your primary residence. A non-Wisconsin resident is not eligible to claim this credit.

If the property qualified as your primary residence on January 1, 2017, submit this completed form to the Oneida County Treasurer. The credit will appear on your 2017 property tax bill.
