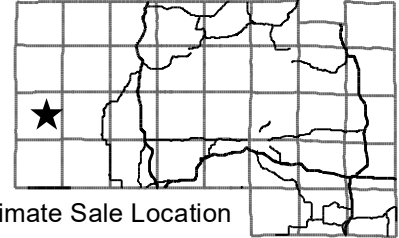
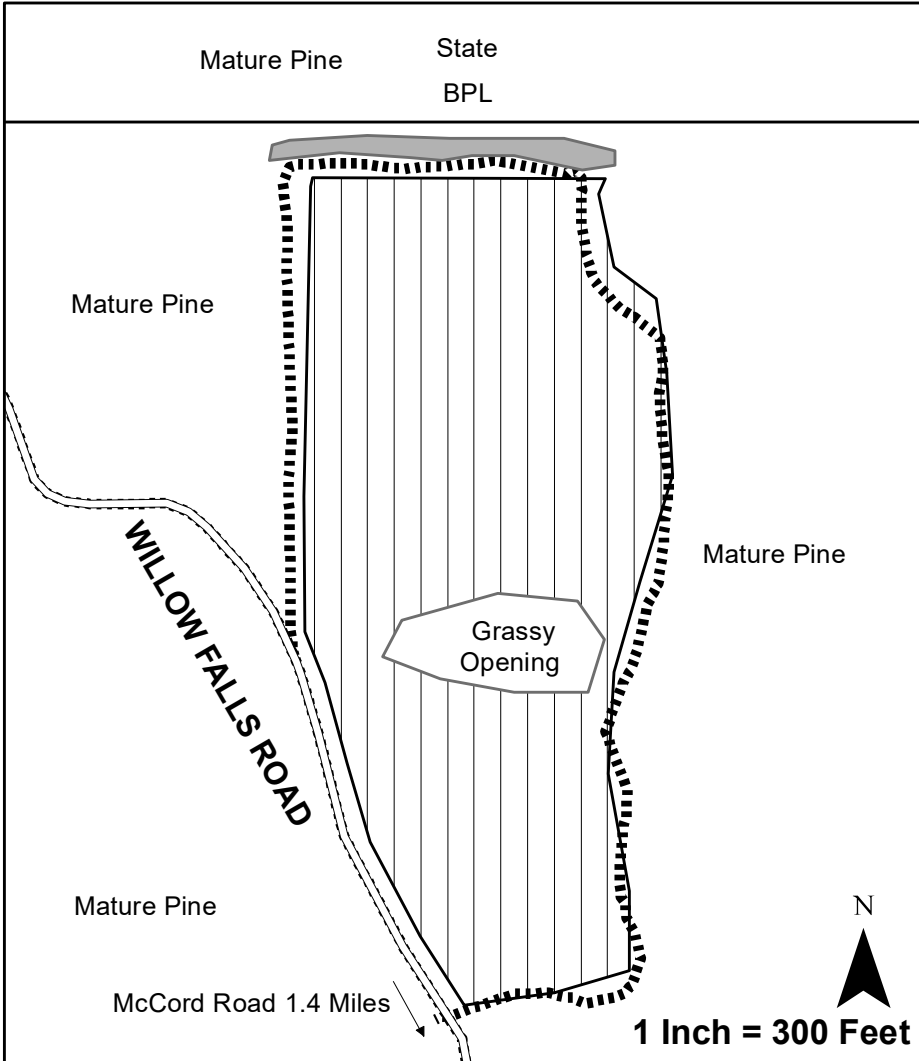

Additional Regulations

1. In the strip harvest area, harvest all trees 1 inch and larger within each cutting strip. Strips shall be approximately 15 feet wide and oriented in a north-south direction. The first and last trees in each strip are identified by three orange dots, arranged vertically on the stems. Trees in the center of the strip are designated by a vertical orange stripe.
2. In the marked to cut area, harvest all trees marked with orange paint.
3. Utilization on all species is a 100" stick to a 4" top. Whole tree harvesting is not permitted. Any den or nest trees shall be left uncut. Standing dead trees are not to be cut unless they pose a safety hazard.
4. All pine cut from April 1 to August 15 must be skidded and hauled within two weeks of cutting. Time restrictions may be imposed if excessive rutting occurs in the woods or on the roads or if excessive damage to the residual trees occurs. If, in the opinion of the County, excessive damage to the residual stand cannot be avoided by the contractor, additional harvesting restrictions will be imposed or the contract may be cancelled.
5. No new road construction will be permitted. Logs may be decked along Willow Falls Road only with permission from the town. The grass opening may be used for decking or a turn-around but must be levelled and cleared of all slash. Following completion of the sale, all trails will be returned to their original condition or better. Bond money will not be returned until all road work is completed.
6. Willow Falls Road is an ATV and snowmobile route and must be maintained in safe usable condition at all times. Signs shall be posted while harvesting and hauling.
7. No equipment is allowed outside of the sale area, and all slash must be pulled back into the sale area. Slash must be pulled back a minimum of 25 feet from Willow Falls Road and must be cut to within two feet of the ground within the entire sale. All trees felled across the blue paint line must be pulled back into sale area before limbing.
8. Stump height must not exceed 10".
9. All items listed in the Oneida County Timber Sale Contract apply. All applicable BMP's will be followed. Sale established by AJ/PF 7/2016

NOTE: Heterobasidion Root Disease preventative spraying requirements will be implemented if the disease is found in Oneida County or an adjacent county prior to or during the period of this contract. See Timber Sale Contract for details.
