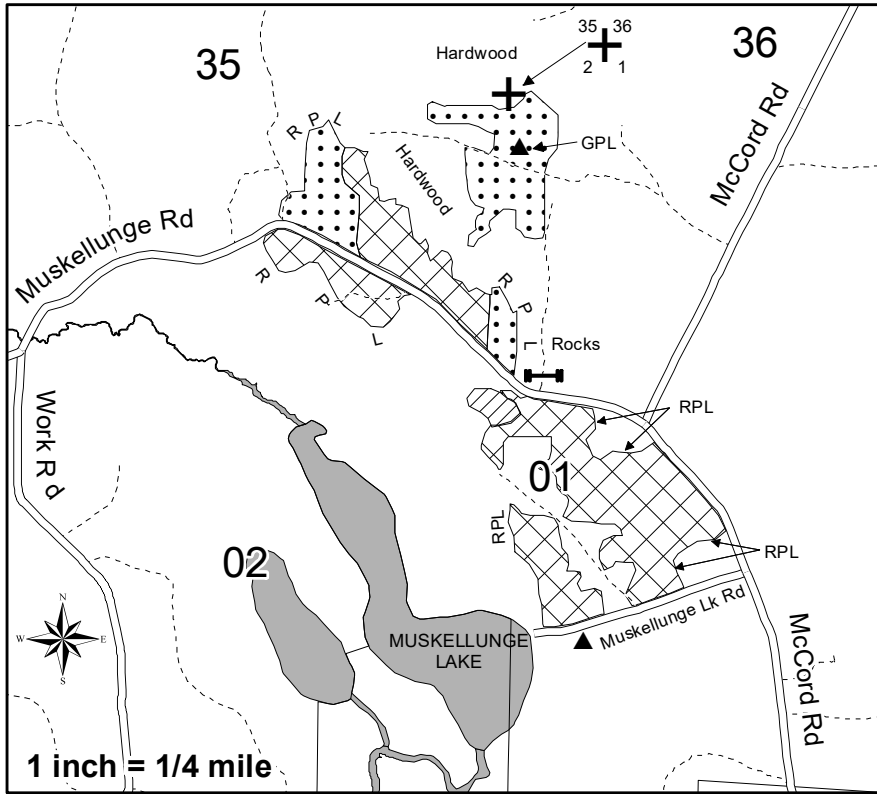


Oneida County Forest McMusk Pine Spruce

NOTE: Heterobasidion (Annosum) Root Rot preventative spraying requirements will be implemented if Heterobasidion (Annosum) Root Rot is found in Oneida County or an adjacent county prior to or during the period of this contract. See Timber Sale Contract for details.

Additional Regulations:

- In the Harvest Areas cut only Spruce, Pine and Hardwood marked with orange paint leaving orange visible on the stump. Do not cut any other species. Utilization on all species is a 100" stick to a 4" top. Any den or nest trees shall be left uncut. Standing dead trees are not to be cut unless they pose a safety hazard.
- Dry or frozen ground conditions will be required for harvesting and hauling activities. Year round operations will be permitted as long as rutting or road damage does not occur. Time restrictions may be imposed if excessive rutting occurs in the woods or on the roads or if excessive damage to the residual trees occurs.
- Existing roads may be opened and improved and landing sites and stub roads may be constructed with prior approval of the County. All roads and landings must be leveled at the end of each harvest season and at the end of the sale. The road to the north spruce area must be blocked off at the end of each harvest season and at the end of the sale. Bond money will not be returned until all road/landing rehabilitation is complete.
- Decking or skidding on McCord, Muskeellunge or Muskeellunge Lk Roads will only be done with permission of the Town of Lynne and only when the road is dry or frozen to prevent damage. Wood decked along the road must be kept far enough off the road so as not to pose a danger to traffic.
- No equipment or slash is allowed in the wetland areas within or adjacent to the sale. Equipment may not be operated within 15 feet of any wetland unless ground is dry or frozen.
- No Whole Tree Skidding allowed. Maximum pole length is 17' for skidding. Utility poles will be dealt with on a case by case basis.
- Slash must be pulled back a minimum of 25 ft from the edge of the Town Roads and must be cut to no higher than 2 ft throughout the sale.
- No equipment or felling is allowed on the sites of the old logging camps. The northern camp has a green line painted around it. The southern one is south of the road.
- All items listed in the Oneida County Timber Sale Contract apply. All applicable BMP's will be followed. Sale Est. PF/JR/ER/DNR 12/17
