Invitation for Sealed Bids on Timber Stumpage

Sealed bids will be accepted for previously advertised tracts by the Oneida County Forestry Department at the Oneida County Court House, Second Floor, Room B206, Rhinelander, WI 54501 **UNTIL NOON ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 6, 2018**. There are 4 tracts of timber for sale in the town of Lynne comprising 546 acres. Total volume estimates are as follows:

The outside of the envelope must show the tract number and contractor name. Bids must include:

1. Tract number.
2. List of species to be cut and estimated volume.
3. Bid prices per Ton or MBF for each species and product.
4. Signature and address of each bidder.
5. A refundable bid bond in the form of a check or cash must accompany each bid for the amount of 5% of the total bid value.

Successful bidders must provide proof of training to the State SFI standards at the time of contract signing. Minimum required deposit is 25% of successful bid value for each tract. The Forestry, Land, and Recreation Committee reserves the right to reject any or all bids and/or to select the bid most advantageous to Oneida County.

Bids will be publicly opened Wednesday, June 6, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. in Committee Room #1, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Oneida County Court House, Rhinelander, WI. Successful bids will be awarded at the regularly scheduled Oneida County Forestry, Land, & Recreation Committee meeting. The meeting is scheduled to begin at 3:30 p.m on Wednesday, June 6, 2018 in Committee Room #2 of the Oneida County Courthouse, second floor, Rhinelander, WI.
