

Oneida County Automatic Aid Agreement

Automatic aid is assistance dispatched automatically by contractual agreement between two communities or fire department (districts). The Oneida County 911 Center under the direction of the sheriff shall automatically dispatch emergency response resources according to the following agreement:

INSTRUCTIONS

Municipal Agreement: The Municipal Agreement is an agreement between two municipal fire departments. Fill in the names of both departments on the lines provided.

Geographical Area: Fill in the name of the township the geographical area this agreement refers to.

Example: If Sugar Camp and Three Lakes have an agreement that if Sugar Camp has a structure fire both Sugar Camp and Three Lakes Fire Departments will be paged. Sugar Camp would be filled in as the geographical area.

ESN Zone Number: From the Oneida County ESN Zone Map fill in the ESN number that covers that geographical area.

WHEREAS it is the intention of the Three Lakes Fire Department to assist the Sugar Camp Fire Department with fire related activities in the following events:

Structure fires located within the geographical area of Sugar Camp Township as designated by Oneida County ESN Zone number 824.



Signatures: Both Fire Chief's from the participating township must sign and date the Municipal Agreement.
