


Parking is available at the lot on Hancock Oneida Lake Rd. Please do not park on other Town Roads.

Dogs are allowed on the trail but must be kept under the owners control at all times. Please clean up after your pet.



NOSE LAKE SKI TRAIL

The Nose Lake Ski Trail is located 12 miles west of Rhinelander between Hwy K and Hwy 8. in Oneida County. The trail has two main loops: the east loop is 4.6 miles long and the west loop is 2.6 miles long with a 0.7 mile connector trail between the two loops.

There is two way traffic so please keep to the right. The trail is groomed for tracked skiing only.

Skill Level: Beginner to Intermediate.

Please stay on trails. No snowshoeing on ski trail

A TRAIL PASS IS REQUIRED FOR ALL PERSONS 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.

Trail passes are available at all trail heads or from the Oneida County Forestry Office and local businesses.
