



A trail pass is required for all persons 18 years of age or older for snowshoeing or skiing on the nature trails. Trail passes are available at the trailhead map kiosk located in the east parking lot, and at the Forestry Office.

No pets are allowed on the beach or in picnic areas or public buildings. Pets are allowed in other parts of the park provided they are leashed.

No glass allowed in the park.

The use of Bicycles and Motorcycles is limited to the asphalt parking lots and roadways. No bicycles or motorcycles are allowed on beach or in picnic areas.

No fires allowed except in picnic grills for the purpose of cooking.

Restrooms are open May 15 through October 31.

A full set of regulations is posted on the sign board near the parking lot. Refer to Ch. 14 of the Oneida County code for full regulations.

The park is open from 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.

Almon Park is located approximately 5 miles south of Rhinelander on Buck Lake. This 160 acre park consists of a swimming beach, picnic areas and shelters, nature trails and a disc golf course. Restrooms are located near the beach and at the upper level picnic area. Changing rooms are also located at the beach. The upper level picnic area and shelter may be reserved for private functions after Memorial Day through Labor Day (excluding Holidays). Contact the Forestry Department for rental information. The nature trails are open for hiking, skiing and snowshoeing.
