BE IT RESOLVED, The Oneida County Board of Supervisors supports, in concept, the development by the Crandon Mining Company of the proposed pipeline for the transport of treated wastewater from the proposed mine site in Forest County, with that portion of the pipeline crossing Oneida County to be located primarily within the right-of-ways of U.S. Highway 8 and Wisconsin Highway 17 from the Forest County line to the outfall at the Wisconsin River near the Hat Rapids Dam, provided the design, construction, operation and closure of the pipeline meets all current and future state and federal regulations.
