Resolution offered by John J. Hogan, and Wilbur J. Petroskey.

Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin
That

WHEREAS, the Mining Investment and Local Impact Fund Board may
award Discretionary grants to local units of government to
alleviate social, environmental, educational, or economic impacts
of metallic mineral mining.

WHEREAS, units of government eligible to apply for discretionary
grants include Wisconsin counties and cities.

WHEREAS, the Mining Investment and Local Impact Fund Board has
adopted an overall funding ceiling for the 1995 grant program of
\$20,000.

WHEREAS, the Mining Investment and Local Impact Fund Board is
authorized to grant discretionary awards for the purposes
specified in s.70,395(2)(g), Stats. and s. TAX 13.08(8) Wis. Adm.
Code.

WHEREAS, Oneida County is likely to experience social, economic,
environmental and other impacts by the proposed mining operation
of the Crandon Mining Company near Crandon, WI, to include the
proposed treated wastewater pipeline and subsequent discharge
into the Wisconsin River.

WHEREAS, the Oneida County Mining Impact Committee and Board of
Supervisors feel that a thorough investigation of socio-economic
and related impacts is necessary before the negotiation of a
local agreement.

WHEREAS, to ensure adequate time to review and analyze socio-
economic data and to plan appropriately for the future,
investigation of mining related impacts must begin immediately.

WHEREAS, it is estimated that it will cost about \$5,000 to
complete a review and analysis of socio-economic data related to
the Crandon Mining Company project in Forest and Oneida counties.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Oneida County supports the
project, and will commit up to \$500 in general fund balance to be
used as local matching funds/in-kind services which represents 10
percent of the funds necessary to complete the project.
