

RESOLUTION

Resolution offered by Fred Feller.

INTENT: To allocate two hundred seventy three dollars and eighty cents (\$273.80) in the 1987 budget as a share of the cash match required for the 1987 grant to the North Central Mining Impact Planning Committee from the Wisconsin Mining Investment and Local Impact Fund Board.

WHEREAS, a grant application in the amount of ten thousand nine hundred fifty two dollars and nine cents (\$10,952.09) is being made on behalf of the four counties of Forest, Oneida, Langlade, and Vilas to the Wisconsin Mining Investment and Local Impact Fund Board to provide informational workshops and administrative costs for 1987.

WHEREAS, the County of Oneida is an active participant in the North Central Mining Impact Planning Committee and concerned with the impacts on the developing mining industry, and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Mining Investment and Local Impact Fund Board now requires a minimum ten percent (10%) cash match to obtain a grant, and

WHEREAS, the North Central Mining Impact Planning Committee has requested that each member unit share the ten percent (10%) cash match to obtain a grant.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida County Board of Supervisors agrees to allocate a minimum of two hundred seventy three dollars and eighty cents (\$273.80) in the 1987 budget as part of the cash match required by the Wisconsin Mining Investment and Local Impact Fund Board for the discretionary grant to the North Central Mining Impact Planning Committee.
