Parents who Host Lose the MOST	<p>Jeff gave an update on the Tavern League presentation that he and Melissa Werner gave last month. There were approximately 35 tavern owners who listened to the information on the PHW campaign to discourage adults from providing minors alcohol. Tony Albright sent a THANKYOU to Channel 9 for the positive messages that they aired about the risk of teenage drinking. Marathon County has been doing compliance checks and is willing to provide Compliance Check Training to other interested law enforcement officers upon request. Jeremy McClain said that Columbus County also had a successful campaign with the help of law enforcement. Egnasus Rodriguez from the Northwoods YMCA is the coordinator for this program. Rhinelander Chief of Police, Mike Steffe is very supportive of this program. The County is wondering if the <i>Restorative Justice Program</i> is duplicating services. The Minocqua area students will be conducting a second site for TEEN Court for Oneida County this year.
