2010 AODA Coalition Workplan	A sub-committee of Jeff Knudson, Karen Knudson, Yvette Hittle, Anne Cirilli, Erica Brewster and Kathy Muntner met before the regular meeting to discuss ideas to be included in the 2010 Oneida Co. Northwoods Coalition Logic Models	Karen is working on a re-vision of the SPF SIG logic model Workplan to establish a Parent Network for parents with students in the grades 6 th thru 8 th in Oneida County by Dec. 31, 2011. This will include three community forums designed to increase parents' awareness of alcohol related risks for youth between the ages of 13 and 15. Northwoods Coalition will pay us \$500.00 to complete this Workplan by the end of March, 2010.	Karen Knudson
Joint Coalition Meeting	The last Joint Coalition meeting was held on Monday, Jan 4 th in St. Germain. They reviewed the <i>Community Perception</i> survey results. He announced that the GLIT/Mentoring project is going to apply for the federal prevention grant for the next (Year 6 – 10) continuation.	Jeremy McClain
Mentoring Grant Update: COMMUNITY Perception Survey	517 responses have been entered into the data base. The survey was promoted through the radio and TV stations as well as flyers in local establishments. People were offered either a paper survey of an on-line application. Two digital cameras (one from Oneida Co. AODA and one from Vilas Co. PAC) were offered as prizes for completed surveys. Approx. 50% of respondents were from each County. Ages were also evenly divided. Their most pressing issue was the <i>misuse</i> of alcohol. <i>Tobacco</i> and <i>Rx abuse</i> tied for second. Small changes (corrections) will be made to the next survey to be done in two years. The results will be tabulated and shared with the two Coalitions and the news media. Data may be used for SPF SIG Grant writing in the future.	Erica Brewster
