Environmental Strategies, UAD & PWH	<p>Lynn passed out a DPI brochure on the 2009 WI YBRS results. Statewide some improvements, but increase in marijuana use. Our local data shows some decrease in frequency of UAD but increased binge drinking.</p> <p>Three Lakes will be sending out letters to parents re: prom/ graduation and UAD.
