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3 **GENERAL CODE OF ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN**  
4 **ORDINANCE AMENDMENT #**

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6 **Ordinance Amendment offered by Supervisors of the Commission on Aging,**

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8 **Whereas, Oneida County is facing budget cuts throughout the entire county**  
9 **structure due to levy limits that have been put in place by the State of Wisconsin; and**

10 **Whereas, the Commission on Aging has reviewed the size of their committee to**  
11 **determine if it was necessary to continue to have 11 but not more than 15 members; and**

12 **Whereas, the Commission on Aging has determined that in order to save costs for**  
13 **Oneida County the Commission can effectively carry out it duties with 9 but not more than**  
14 **11 members.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**  
16 **DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

17 Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in conflict  
18 with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists.

19 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication as  
20 required by law.

21 Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged  
22 unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the  
23 remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

24 Section 4. Section 2.51(1) of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is  
25 amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]:

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27 **2.51 COMMISSION ON AGING.**

28 (1) **COMPOSITION AND APPOINTMENT.** ~~The Commission on Aging shall~~  
29 ~~consist of at least 11 but not more than 15 members, appointed by the County~~  
30 ~~Board Chair, subject to confirmation by the County Board. At least 51% of the~~  
31 ~~members shall be senior citizens 60 years of age or over, and at least one member~~  
32 ~~shall be under the age of 30.~~ **The Commission on Aging shall consist of at least 9**  
33 **but not more than 11 members, appointed by the County Board Chair, subject to**  
34 **confirmation by the County Board. Older individuals shall constitute at least**  
35 **fifty percent of the membership of this commission and individuals who are**  
36 **elected to any office may not constitute fifty percent or more of the membership**  
37 **of this commission.**
