Resolution offered by Labor Relations Employee Services Committee.

Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, the Labor Relations Employee Services Committee (hereinafter, "Committee"), Corporation Counsel, Finance Director and Human Resource Director have met with representatives of the Oneida County Social Worker Association employees bargaining unit represented by WPPA (hereinafter, "Association"); and

WHEREAS, the Committee and the Association have reached a tentative agreement concerning the contract for calendar year 2012; and

WHEREAS, the wage increase set forth below has been recommended by the Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida County Board of Supervisors have reviewed the proposed changes for the purposes of ratification of the agreement between the Committee and the Association.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida County Board of Supervisors does hereby ratify and approve the contract between the Committee and the Association.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Association's contract for 2012 shall incorporate the following:

Social Worker Association wage schedule shall include across the board increase of 1% on January 7, 2012.
