1 **Resolution offered by Supervisors of the Agriculture & Extension Education/Land**
2 **and Water Conservation Committee**

3 **Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:**

4 **WHEREAS**, through 1997 Wisconsin Act 27, Chapter 92 of the Wisconsin
5 Statutes was amended, requiring counties to develop Land and Water Resource
6 Management Plans, and
7

8 **WHEREAS**, Oneida County, pursuant to that amendment, assessed our land and
9 water resource conditions, needs and decided how to best to meet our goals, all of which
10 were included in the Oneida County Land and Water Resource Management Plans
11 approved in 2000 & 2006, and
12

13 **WHEREAS**, the intent of this statutory change was to develop a locally led
14 process that would utilize local, state, and federal funds to develop and implement a 5-
15 year Land and Water Resource Management Plan to protect our land and water
16 resources, and
17

18 **WHEREAS**, the Oneida County Agriculture & Extension Education/Land and
19 Water Conservation Committee brought a diverse group of stakeholders together
20 including local government officials and staff, special interest groups, and citizens, to
21 assist in the development of a new 5-year Land and Water Resource Management Plan,
22 and

24 **WHEREAS**, the Oneida County Agriculture & Extension Education/Land and
25 Water Conservation Committee held a public hearing on August 8, 2011 to accept
26 comments on the Oneida County Land and Water Resource Management Plan, and
27

28 **WHEREAS**, to be eligible to receive soil and water resource management grant
29 funds from the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection
30 (DATCP) Oneida County must submit a plan and funding request based upon an
31 approved Land and Water Resource Management Plan.

33 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Oneida County Board of
34 Supervisors hereby approves the attached 2012-2016 Land and Water Resource
35 Management Plan presented by the Agriculture & Extension Education/Land and Water
36 Conservation Committee,

38 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** a copy of this resolution be provided to
39 DATCP for final State approval of the Plan.
