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7 **WHEREAS**, Resolution #61-2010 reduced the Deputy I position in the County Clerks
8 Office to 50% effective August 2010, and

10 **WHEREAS**, the County Clerk requested the Human Resources Director to review the
11 percentage of time needed for the Deputy I position in the Clerk’s Office due to increased
12 workload from numerous elections, and
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14 **WHEREAS**, the Labor Relations Employee Services Committee did discuss and concur
15 with the recommendation of the Human Resources Director to increase the percentage of time
16 of the position.
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18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors
19 that effective February 22, 2012 the Deputy Clerk I position shall be increased to an 80% part-
20 time position for the remainder of 2012. The Deputy I position will be evaluated prior to the end
21 of the year to determine the appropriate percentage of time for 2013 to be reviewed by the
22 Labor Relations Employee Services Committee.
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24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors that by
25 adoption of this resolution it shall be deemed that an amendment has been made to the County
26 budget for fiscal year 2012 to reflect all projected costs for the position as set forth in the fiscal
27 impact statement which is attached hereto and made a part hereof with a transfer from the
28 contingency fund.
