**GENERAL CODE OF ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN  
ORDINANCE AMENDMENT #**

**Ordinance Amendment offered by Supervisors of the Finance and Insurance  
Committee**

**Whereas**, during the budget hearing on the 2012 budget a motion was made, seconded and passed to decrease the mileage reimbursement rate to forty-five cents (\$0.45) per mile; and

**Whereas**, an ordinance amendment is required to effectuate that change; and  
**NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication as required by law.

Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Section xxxxxx of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]:

**3.10 REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.**

(1) APPLICATION. This section shall apply to the following:

- (a) County Board Supervisors.
- (b) Citizen members of committees.
- (c) Elected County officials.
- (d) All County employees if authorized by County Board resolution or ordinance, or by authorization of the committee in charge of the department in which the person is employed.

(2) MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT.

- (a) Privately Owned Vehicles.
  - 1. All persons shall be reimbursed at ~~the federal reimbursement rate~~ a rate of forty-five cents (\$0.45) per mile for each mile actually traveled in their privately owned vehicle, as calculated herein, subject to the exceptions set forth below.
