6 Ordinance Amendment offered by Land Records Committee

8 WHEREAS, upon review of the ordinances it was discovered that County Code
9 section 3.15 does not accurately reflect the rates currently required to be charged
10 pursuant to statute; and

11 WHEREAS, in order for the County code to reflect the proper charges an
12 amendment needs to be made; and

13 NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
14 DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

15 Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in
16 conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists.

17 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication
18 as required by law.

19 Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged
20 unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the
21 remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

22 Section 4. Section 3.15 of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is
23 amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]:

25 **3.15 RECORDING AND COPYING FEES.** (Am. #50-2004)

26 (1) REGISTER OF DEEDS RECORDING FEES.

27 (a) The fee for recording ~~certificate and~~ preparing and mailing documents
28 shall be in accordance with ~~under~~ §59.43, Wis. Stats., ~~shall be \$11.~~

29 (b) ~~For each additional page required for instruments submitted for recording~~
30 ~~under § 59.43, Wis. Stats., the fee of \$2 shall be charged.~~
