Resolution offered by Supervisor Ted Cushing.

Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, Resolution #60-2008 created a part-time (35%) Medical Examiner position with a pay structure that included per diem payments for service calls and a salary for administrative work, and

WHEREAS, the Human Resources Director and Finance Director did meet with the Medical Examiner to evaluate the efficiency and cost effectiveness of the current pay structure, and

WHEREAS, the Human Resources Director did recommend to the Labor Relations Employee Services Committee that the current pay structure for the Medical Examiner position should be modified, and

WHEREAS, the Labor Relations Employee Services Committee did agree with the proposed pay structure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors that, effective January 1, 2013, the part-time (35%) Medical Examiner position be increased to a full-time (100%) Medical Examiner position and no longer be eligible for per diems for service calls.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors that by adoption of the resolution it shall be deemed that an amendment has been made to the County budget for fiscal year 2013 as set forth in the fiscal impact statement which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
