

RESOLUTION # 38-2013

Resolution offered by the Land Records Committee.

Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, Oneida County retained a 100 foot strip of land on each side of the center line of existing roads crossing the Northwest ¼ - Northwest ¼ of Section 36, Township 35 North, Range 11 East, as recorded in Volume 208 of Deeds, Page 184, Document Number 163634, together with timber rights on said land, recorded in the Register of Deeds on July 27th, 1955; and,

WHEREAS, David J Wolczewski and Shari R Wolczewski, adjoining landowners to the above described strip of land submitted a request to Oneida County to purchase a portion of the 100 foot strip of land adjoining County Z and has paid the \$500.00 administrative fee to process this request; and,

WHEREAS, the Oneida County Highway Commissioner does not object to this request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida County Board of Supervisors hereby approves conveying the following described parcel of land and authorizes the County Clerk, upon receipt of the recording fee of \$30.00 and land value of \$194.65, to issue a quit claim deed to the adjoining landowner as set forth below, conveying any interest the County has in the following description.

To: David J Wolczewski and Shari R Wolczewski, Husband and Wife as survivorship marital property, 580 County Z, Pelican Lake WI 54463.

That part of lands owned by Oneida County as retained in Volume 208 of deeds, Page 184 being located in the Northwest ¼ - Northwest ¼ (NW ¼-NW ¼) of Section 36, Township 35 North, Range 11 East, that lies between the north and south lines of the 1 acre of land in the NW corner of the NW-NW described in V208 Page 184 extended westerly to a line that is 35' east of and parallel to the west line of said NW ¼ - NW ¼. Subject to easements, utilities or access of record or in use by others across said lands. This strip to be attached to lands in Document # 726058, parcel number SC 704-1.
