

RESOLUTION #30-2009

Resolution offered by Supervisors of the **Forestry, Land, & Outdoor Recreation Committee. Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:**

WHEREAS, Oneida County, along with towns and cities located within Oneida County, have invested considerable time and resources to develop outdoor recreation facilities for its residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida County Forestry, Land, & Outdoor Recreation Committee directs the development and maintenance of the County Forest park and recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, numerous individuals and organizations utilize these facilities for a wide range of outdoor recreation programs and activities; and

WHEREAS, outdoor recreation facilities are important amenities supporting the tourism industry; and

WHEREAS, an approved five-year outdoor recreation plan is essential for the County to be eligible to apply for grant funds from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Stewardship Program and other sources; and

WHEREAS, Oneida County’s Five-Year Outdoor Recreation Plan was developed for the County by the North Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission under the direction of the Forestry, Land, & Outdoor Recreation Committee, with input from private citizens, recreation clubs, and town, city, and county officials; so

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Oneida County Five-Year Outdoor Recreation Plan for the years 2009—2013 and directs the Committee to submit the plan, together with a copy of this resolution, to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for certification.
