5 increased from \$100.00 to \$125.00; and

11 Examiner's Office on a monthly basis for each cremation or disinterment permit

15 permit fees for cremations and disinterments shall be increased from \$100.00 to
16 \$125.00.

19 Medical Examiner's Office on a monthly basis for each cremation or disinterment permit
20 executed by the Medical Examiner's Office in their behalf.
