**GENERAL CODE OF ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN
ORDINANCE AMENDMENT #**

**Ordinance Amendment offered by Supervisors of the
Finance & Insurance Committee**

Whereas, the fee for a Transient Merchant's Permit has been the same for many years, and

Whereas, the fee for a background check now exceeds the Permit fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication as required by law.

Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Section 12.01(3) of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]:

Chapter 12 LICENSES AND PERMITS

12.01 LICENSES REQUIRED.

A license shall be required for each of the following businesses or activities at the indicated license fee, which shall be for one year unless otherwise indicated:

(1) & (2) Remain unchanged

(3) TRANSIENT MERCHANTS. ~~\$5~~ \$50 investigation fee.
