**GENERAL CODE OF ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN  
ORDINANCE AMENDMENT #**

**Ordinance Amendment offered by Supervisors of the Resolutions &  
Ordinances/Legislative Committee**

Whereas, the policy that allows Public Participation at a County Board Meeting requires that a Supervisor receive approval from the Chair for a constituent to speak, and

Whereas, this procedure may seem to hinder true public participation, and  
Whereas, public participation is encouraged at committee meetings and should be at the full Board meetings.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication as required by law.

Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Section 2.02 of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]:

2.02 RULE 2: ORDER OF BUSINESS. (Am. #51-94; #72-94; #20-2008)

The order of business shall be as follows:

(1) CALL TO ORDER. At the appointed hour for the meeting, the Chair shall call the Board to order requesting that the members rise for a brief moment of silence followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

(2) ROLL CALL. The Clerk shall then call the roll of members in alphabetical order.

(3) ANNOUNCEMENTS BY THE CHAIR, CORRESPONDENCE AND COMMUNICATION.

(4) ACCEPT MINUTES OF PREVIOUS COUNTY BOARD MEETING(S).

(5) REPORTS.

(6) UNFINISHED BUSINESS.

(Sections 1-6 remain unchanged)

(7) PUBLIC COMMENT. Persons present will be allowed up to two minutes time to express their opinion on any resolution that appears on the agenda. The Board, by a majority vote, may allow additional time for a speaker.
