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9 **WHEREAS**, Oneida County is committed to utilize interoperable communications for  
10 the most efficient and effective incident management by our public safety agencies, and  
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12 **WHEREAS**, the sixteen (16) counties that include Florence, Forest, Langlade, Lincoln,  
13 Marathon, Marinette, Menominee, Oconto, Oneida, Portage, Price, Shawano, Taylor, Vilas,  
14 Waupaca, and Wood counties have previously utilized \$640,000 in federal funds to create a  
15 regional Public Safety Mobile Radio Plan (PSMRP). This plan is a critical component for long  
16 range planning and the development of future public safety two-radio systems, and  
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18 **WHEREAS**, these counties have formed *North East Wisconsin Public Safety*  
19 *COMmunications, NEWCOM*, which is a working group that includes Federal, State, Tribal, and  
20 Regional Planning Commissions to address the needs of an interoperable public safety mobile  
21 radio system that best meets the needs of public safety in a cost effective manner, and  
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23 **WHEREAS**, Oneida County has nearly completed Phase I of this radio interoperability  
24 project, and  
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26 **WHEREAS**, Oneida County currently needs to further develop this high level PSMRP  
27 document into a more detailed system design for Phase II of the project, and  
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29 **WHEREAS**, a more detailed cost estimate for Phase II of the project will allow County  
30 elected officials to accurately consider budgeting for the project, and the County Board of  
31 Supervisors can in turn make informed decisions concerning the future of two-way public safety  
32 communications in Oneida County, and  
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34 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Oneida County Board of  
35 Supervisors does hereby approve the expenditure of up to \$30,000 from the General Fund to hire  
36 professional services to assist with the planning, engineering, and detailed cost study of Phase II  
37 of the public safety radio system project in Oneida County.
