Resolution offered by Supervisors of the Labor Relations Employee Services Committee.

Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Oneida County Corporation Counsel that after the earliest time for filing nomination papers, the County cannot enact any salary adjustments pertaining to the elected positions of Sheriff and Clerk of Court, and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to provide fair and equitable wage increase to the Offices of Sheriff and Clerk of Court, for the term of office, and

WHEREAS, the Labor Relations Employee Services Committee, having reviewed the internal and external wage comparables of the elected positions, does recommend a wage adjustment for each calendar year 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida County Board of Supervisors authorizes and directs that the annual salaries for the positions of Sheriff and Clerk of Court be established as of January 1st of the year indicated below.
