

RESOLUTION # 76-2010

Resolution offered by Supervisors of the Planning and Zoning Committee.

Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, the Oneida County Planning and Zoning Department has the responsibility to review and approve Sanitary Permit Applications and Soil and Site Evaluation Reports pursuant to Chapter 13 of the General Code of Oneida County pertaining to Private Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems (POWTS); and

WHEREAS, Oneida County has not previously issued permits for "At-Risk" septic systems; and

WHEREAS, Oneida County has not performed any maintenance and monitoring of "At-Risk" septic systems in the past; and

WHEREAS, Department of Commerce has requested Oneida County to monitor "At-Risk" septic systems due to the fact that Oneida County staff have the knowledge of the use of these "At-Risk" septic systems and they work closely with the plumbers ; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning staff does take interest in the use and results of "At-Risk" septic systems in Oneida County; and

WHEREAS, Planning and Zoning Department staff will be required to follow the maintenance and monitoring plans submitted with each "At-Risk" septic system reviewed by the Planning and Zoning Department; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Department currently does not have a fee associated with the submittal and review of "At-Risk" septic systems and propose a \$410.00 review fee; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Committee has reviewed the proposed fee and recommends that the fee schedule be changed to include a fee for the review of "At-Risk" septic systems in the amount of \$410.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Oneida County Board of Supervisors supports changing the fee schedule to charge a \$410.00 fee for the review of an "At-Risk" septic system and shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.
