11 and Employee Services Committee, it was determined that the Land Information
12 Director position would be taking on additional duties and responsibilities that would
13 necessitate a reclassification of that position; and

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15 **WHEREAS**, based on the review by the Labor Relations and Employee
16 Services Committee, it was determined that the proposed reclassification was
17 appropriate based upon the changes to the Land Information Director job description.

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19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Oneida County Board of
20 Supervisors that effective January 1, 2009 the Land Information Director position shall
21 be reclassified to Grade Level Fifteen of the Non Represented Classification Pay Plan.
